Even more striking are the courteous and collegial manners displayed, even during the arduous filibuster in the Senate. Practically, the preparation of candidates for confirmation is the most important and exacting duty of the Anglican parish priest, as the administration of the rite is the most arduous of a bishop's tasks; and after a long period of slovenly neglect these duties are now generally discharged with great care: classes are formed and instruction is ...Every thought was bent to attain the end, no labour was deemed to arduous.
