Going Postal is a fantasy novel by British writer Terry Pratchett, the 33rd book in his Discworld series, released in the United Kingdom on 25 September 2004. The United States Postal Service (USPS) is in a "death spiral" as it fears it will run out of cash by 2024. The postmaster general warned Tuesday that unless major changes are made to the model politicians set up to fail, the USPS will be unable to remain solvent. Death is a fictional character in Terry Pratchett's Discworld series and a parody of several other personifications of death.
