The studio practices of the Beatles evolved during the 1960s and, in some cases, influenced the way popular music was recorded. Some of the effects they employed were sampling, artificial double tracking (ADT) and the elaborate use of multitrack recording machines. "A DAY IN THE LIFE" (John Lennon – Paul McCartney) In late 1966, The Beatles were heading down a path that was quickly abandoned. After a few month break, they re-entered EMI Studios refreshed and ready to record their next album, knowing full well that, with their creative juices flowing and no concert tours in the foreseeable future ...There was a period when I thought I didn't write melodies, that Paul wrote those and I just wrote straight, shouting rock 'n' roll. But of course, when I think of some of my own songs – In My Life, or some of the early stuff, This Boy – I was writing melody with the best of them.
