

Download Multicultural Citizenship

The book analyses some of the issues, which, though central to an understanding of multicultural politics (such as language rights, group representation, land rights, federalism, and secession), have been surprisingly neglected in contemporary liberal theory. In this post, I provide a summary of Will Kymlicka's very influential book on multiculturalism, titled *Multicultural Citizenship: a liberal theory of minority rights*. This article discusses the theory and practice of multicultural citizenship in liberal states. Regarding theory, I point to the shortcomings of both 'radical' and 'liberal' approaches to justify minority rights. In the Winter, 1998 semester, the first section of Sociology 304 will be based on the book, Will Kymlicka, *Multicultural Citizenship: A Liberal Theory of Minority Rights* (Clarendon Press, Oxford, 1995).
