Ismail I (Persian: اسماعیل, romanized: Esmāʿīl, pronounced [esmāʿiːl]; July 17, 1487 – May 23, 1524), also known as Shah Ismail I (شاه اسماعیل), was the founder of the Safavid dynasty, ruling from 1501 to 23 May 1524 as Shah of Iran . The rule of Ismail is one of the most vital in the history of Iran.
